



WELLINGTON ON THE LAKE GOLF COURSE ALCOHOL POLICY

Wellington on the Lake Golf Course is licensed by the Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario. The golf course holds a liquor license for the designated areas of the patio and a golf course endorsement that allows the consumption of alcohol on the golf course.

*** Please Note:** Alcohol is not permitted in the parking lot areas. It is unlawful for anyone to bring their own alcohol to the premise.

The following are the Rules and Regulation for Alcohol Consumption:

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL RULES AND REGULATIONS



All provisions of the Liquor Control Act and the Liquor License Act of Ontario and their regulations must be strictly followed;



No alcoholic beverages other than those provided by the Golf Club shall be permitted anywhere on the premises;

No person shall consume alcoholic beverages to the point of impairment or intoxication;

Any person not adhering to the above rules shall have all privileges suspended and is subject to removal from the premises;



This golf course assumes no liability for any injury, wrongdoing or problem caused by the breach of these rules;

As a condition of the use of the Golf Club's premises and more particularly, the provision of alcoholic beverages by the Golf Club, all persons hereby expressly waive any liability on the part of the Golf Club arising out of the consumption of alcoholic beverages and agree to indemnify and save harmless the Golf Club from any and all claims, damages or law suits referable to the consumption of alcoholic beverages
